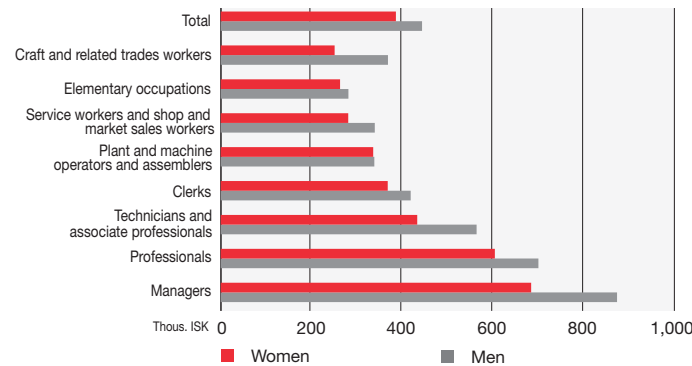
### Positions of influence

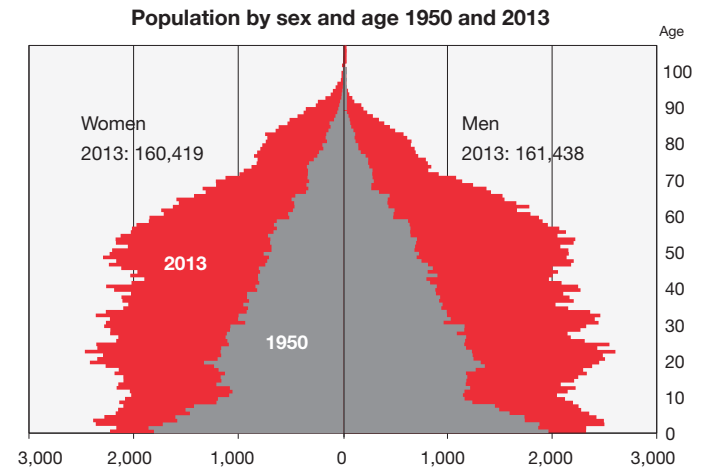


### Regular monthly salaries of FT employees in the private sector 2012

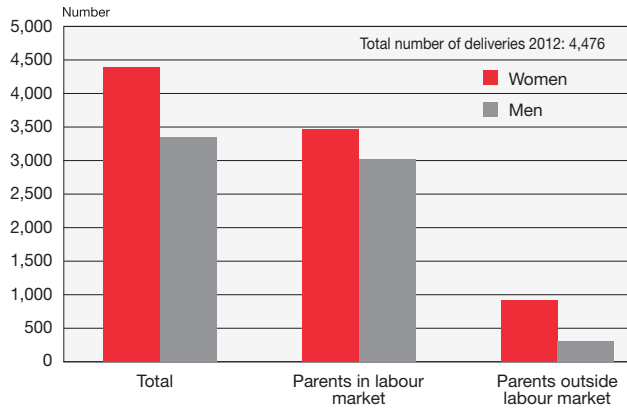

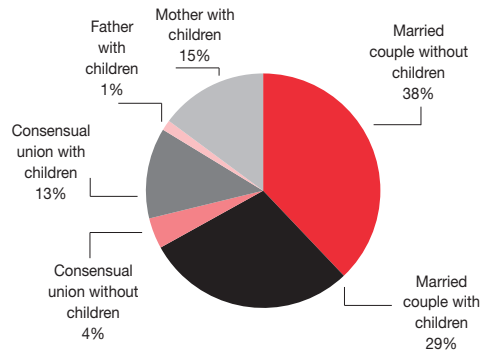

### Parents receiving payments in maternity/paternity leave 2012

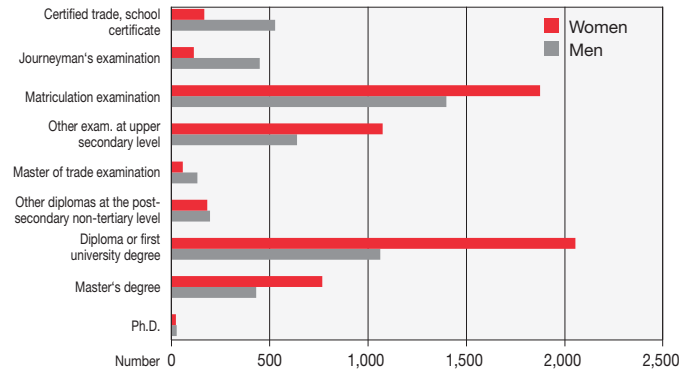

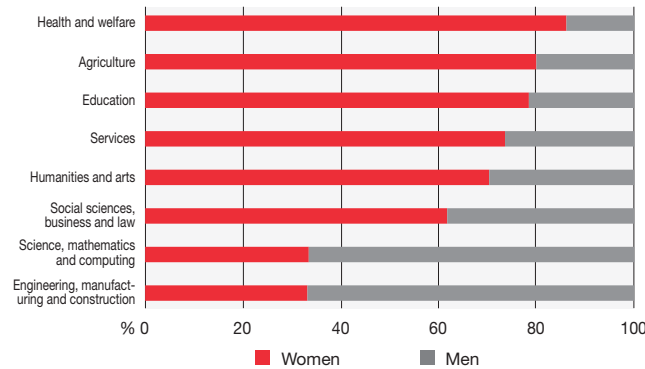

#### Graduations by diploma 2010/2011

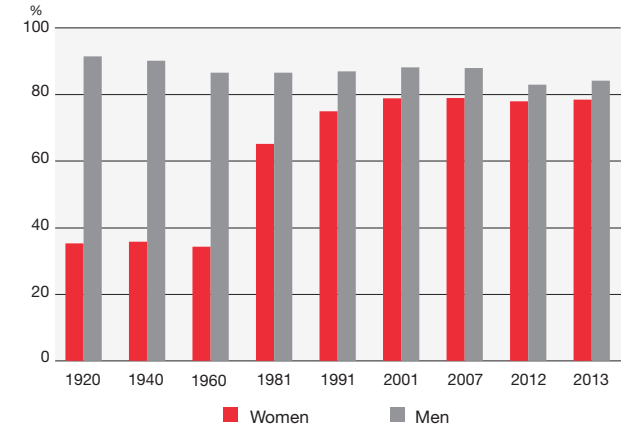


#### Graduations at tertiary level 2010/2011

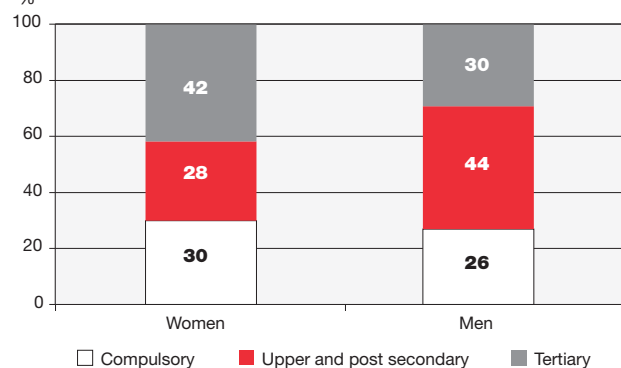
