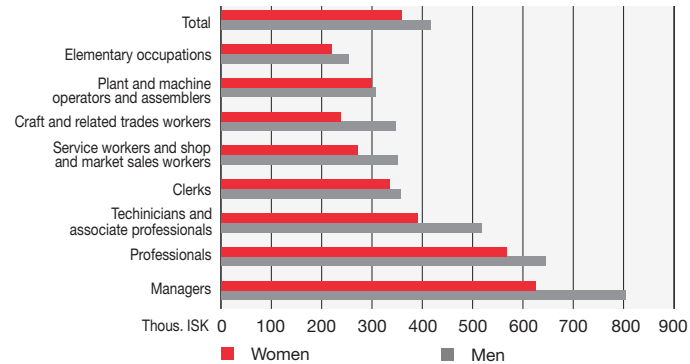
### Positions of influence

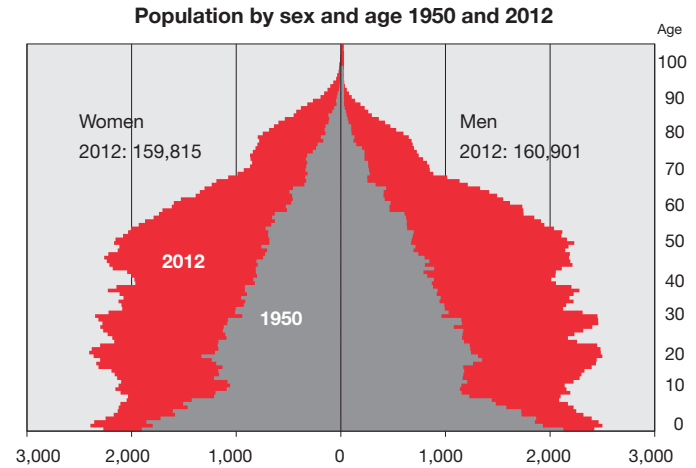


### Regular monthly salaries of FT employees in the private sector 2011

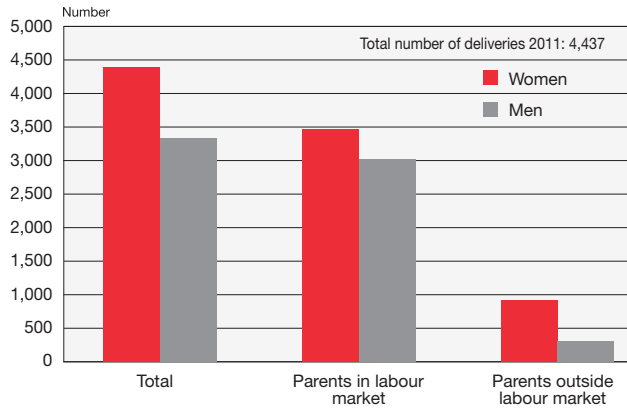

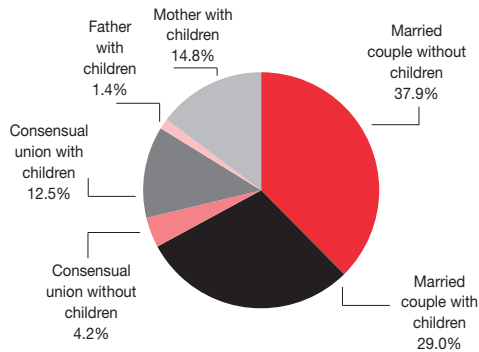

### Parents receiving payments in maternity/paternity leave 2011

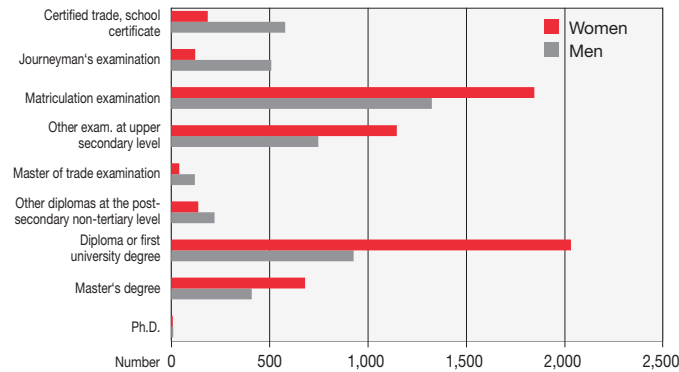

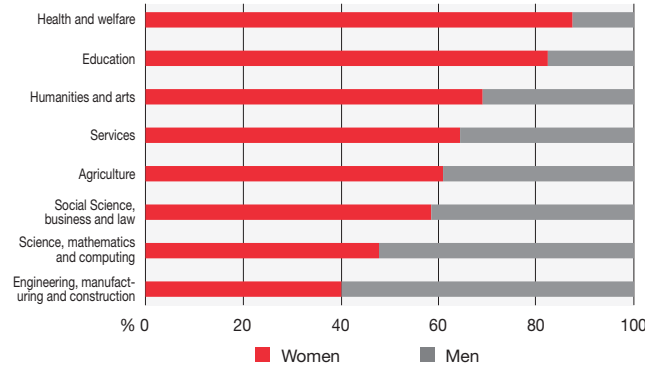

#### Graduations by diploma 2009/2010

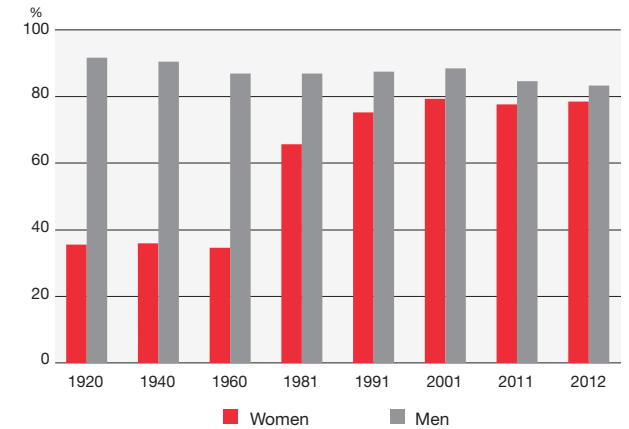


#### Graduations at tertiary level 2009/2010

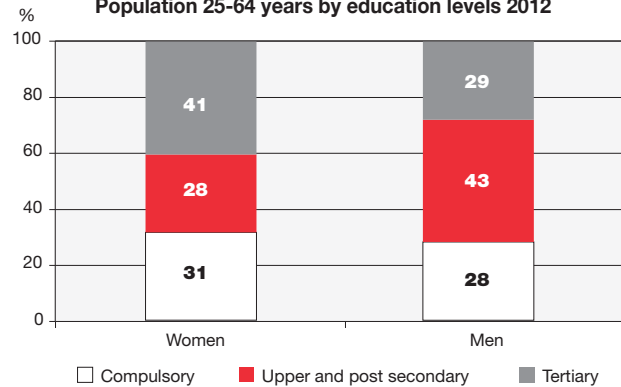
